Synago (syn-AH-go) is the Greek word for “come together.” You may recognize it as the root work of “synagogue,” a place where people come together to worship and to learn the faith. Synago is also the root work of “synergy,” where the coming together of individual parts makes something even greater. And so it is in this Sunday morning small group experience for students in grades 6-12. Groups meet in the Youth Area and are divided between Jr. High and Sr. High students. In coming together to talk about their lives in light of God’s good news, group members grow in relationship with one another and with God.
